

1. Fostering a habit of using English as life-long and self-directed learning and catering for learner diversity



- to conduct Language Across Curriculum programmes(LAC) through collaboration between English department and departments of different content subjects in junior forms and to provide students with various learning experience outside classroom so as to facilitate their learning of other content subjects in English
- to provide professional training for teachers to identify and support gifted students in senior forms by joining the Programme of Gifted Education School Network Initiative by the EDB
- to provide S.1 Bridging Course and to build S.1 students' English foundation



2. Providing opportunities to showcase students' learning outcomes and enhancing their confidence in learning English



- to organize "Lego Serious Play" programme and spelling bees to consolidate students' vocabulary bank of their content subjects
- to arrange students to do announcements, sharing and lunchtime news broadcasts in English
- to organize Global Week and expose students to different cultures through having exchanges with foreigners, for example, meeting with the volunteer team from an American multinational investment bank, Morgan Stanley

2021 HKDSE

- The credit rates, namely level 4 to 5**, of 12 subjects were much higher than HK averages. Among them, the percentages of level 5 or higher in 8 subjects were above HK averages.
- Our overall percentage of level 5* and 5** in 2021 HKDSE was higher than that of the territory by more than 20%.
- The percentage of our students meeting the general entrance requirements for local undergraduate degree programmes was much higher than that of Hong Kong.
